PORTO AIRPORT AWARDED ONCE AGAIN FOR ITS QUALITY OF SERVICE

- The ACI (Airport Council International) ranking honours 3 airports in the VINCI network: Porto, Belgrade and Guanacaste were the best in their category and region
- The awards validate the plans implemented by the VINCI Airports teams to develop these airports.
- Investment in service quality recognised by passengers, responsible for the Airport Quality Service ranking

VINCI Airports, the world's first private airport operator, has seen three of the airports in its network - Belgrade Airport, Serbia, Francisco Sá Carneiro Airport - Porto, Portugal and Guanacaste Airport, Costa Rica - distinguished by ACI (Airport Council International) among the best airports in the world in their category for service quality. The ACI rankings are a global benchmark for the quality of airport services and are of particular importance to those involved in the sector, as they are based on passenger surveys.

Porto airport was named the best European airport in its category. In 2023, it introduced the "Biometric Experience by VINCI Airports", an innovative project being trialled for selected flights and passengers departing from the airport, welcomed new routes operated by new airlines and has plans for further work on the platform. This is the 17th award that Porto airport has received from ACI in this category since 2006. These awards demonstrate VINCI Airports' ability to manage the upturn in global air traffic, confirmed in 2023, while implementing ambitious renovation plans that offer a high level of service and quality results to its passengers.
